Second Face Bourgogne is the “second surface” of the Antique Dalle de Bourgogne flagstones. When an antique floor is reclaimed, the flagstones can be six to eight inches in thickness. Paris Ceramics has developed a way to slice off the antique surface to expose under surfaces. These under surfaces are called the “second face.” The fresh surfaces are then hand textured and polished to give the appearance of an older flagstone. Distressed Bourgogne has all the beauty of the antique floor without the patina of bygone centuries. Distressed Bourgogne is suitable for interior and exterior use.

Distressed Bourgogne is available in approximate sizes:

Random Sizes	x1” to 1¼” in thickness
Coursed Lengths	x1” to 1¼” in thickness
